Laps:

Cat 3 = 2 Laps; Cat 2= 3 Laps; Cat 1= 4 Laps; Cat 1/Pro Open = 5 laps

Each lap is approximately 5.5 miles long. Distances and laps may change due to course conditions.

Cat 3, Cat 2, Cat 1, Pro. See www.h2hrace.com for more detailed breakdown of classes and age categories. There's a category and age group that will fit everyone!

Directions:

From Route 80: Take Exit 25, Route 206 North 5.5 miles towards Andover. One and a half (1.5) miles past the fifth traffic light (Rt. 206 & Rt. 517) make a right onto Goodale Road (Opposite Holiday Motel). Parking will be 1 mile on right.
