Racers from any state are eligible to enter, however the first NJ resident in each class will earn the title of **New Jersey State Mountain Bike Champion**.

Participants must be currently enrolled in a Middle School (grades 6-8) or High School (grades 9-12) and must be age 18 and under. School ID's may be checked. Mountain bikes in good working order are required and helmets are mandatory. Parents or guardians must be present and sign a release form before any student may compete.

**Start Times:** Middle School Men's B at 9:00 am; Middle School Women's Open at 9:01 am  
Middle School Men's A at 9:30 am  
High School Men's B at 10:15 am; High School Women's Open at 11:01 am  
High School Men's A at 11:00 am

**Time:** **Middle School B & Open Women**—25 minutes of racing; **Middle School A**—30 minutes of racing  
**High School B & Open Women**—35 minutes of racing; **High School A**—45 minutes of racing  
**Middle School laps** are about 1.5 miles long and **High School laps** are about 2 miles long of **FUN** rolling single-track and some gravel road. Times and laps may change due to course conditions.

**Classes:** **Men's B**—Novice mountain biker with little or no race experience  
**Men's A**—Experienced mountain biker with lots of riding experience or race experience  
**Women's Open**—Novice and experienced bikers alike

**Directions**

**From Route 80:** Take Exit 25, Route 206 North 5.5 miles towards Andover. One and a half (1.5) miles past the fifth traffic light (Rt. 206 & Rt. 517) make a right onto Goodale Road (Opposite Holiday Motel). Parking will be 1 mile on right.

The race start is then on the other side of Goodale Road from the parking lot. Please be careful as you cross the road.
