Any bicycle with fat tires (it doesn't have to be a geared mountain bike) and in good working order is eligible to race. **Helmets are mandatory. Parents or guardians must be present** to sign a release form and **must be present during the race.**

**Registration:** Registration opens at 11:15 am and closes 15 minutes before the start of each category.

**Price and Prizes:** \$10 for all classes Awards for all participants! Medals and prizes for Champions!

**Start Times:** Kindergarten and First Grade Boys at 12:15 pm; Girls at 12:16 pm  
Second and Third Grade Boys at 12:25 pm; Girls at 12:26 pm  
Fourth and Fifth Grade Boys at 12:45 pm; Girls at 12:46 pm  
*Boys and girls may be combined in the event of smaller fields.*

**Distances:** Kindergarten and First Grade about 0.75 mile  
Second and Third Grade about 1.5 miles  
Fourth Grade & Fifth Grade about 3 miles  
 The laps are about 0.75 mile long (1 mile long for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade) and it's a great course for spectators and photographers. It's a combination of some smooth single-track and gravel road.
