Boys and girls may be combined in the event of smaller fields.

Course: Racers will be completing multiple laps of a short and fun course consisting of smooth single-track, grass, and gravel road. It's a great course for spectators and photographers. The laps and overall race duration are age appropriate as tested over the last eight years.
